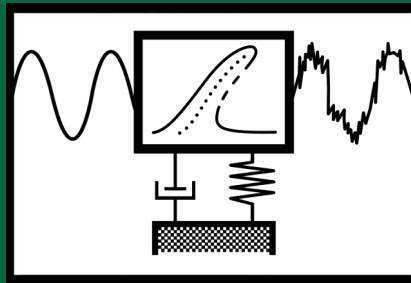


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JVE Journal of Vibroengineering

The following structure of the manuscript is recommended: abstract, keywords, nomenclature, introduction, main text, results, conclusions and references. Manuscript should be single-spaced, one column ISO B5 175 × 248 mm format, using Microsoft Word 2007 or higher. Margins: top 13 mm, bottom 17 mm, left 26 mm, right 13 mm, header 8 mm, footer 13 mm.
